

# Adopt a Classroom

The Corps has developed a curriculum for students based on the Onondaga Lake cleanup. The activities are designed to reinforce New York State standards and Next Generation Science Standards. Students learn how science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) have led to improvements in Onondaga Lake and the surrounding areas. This includes the resurgence of about 90 acres of wetlands on the shores of Onondaga Lake and along the lake's tributaries, which benefits birds, fish, other wildlife, and people in our community. The goal of the curriculum is to help students understand the value of Onondaga Lake as an Important Bird Area while participating in engaging classroom and field trip activities.
