Comptroller DiNapoli has been an environmental champion for Long Island Sound in New York State for decades. During his 20 years with the State Assembly and as Chairman of the Environmental Conservation Committee, he sponsored and helped to enact ground-breaking legislation to protect water quality. As State Comptroller, he has promoted the restoration of water resources, most notably through reports on New York's infrastructure needs. He also launched an ambitious Green Initiative to promote and audit cost-effective, environmentally sustainable practices across New York State agencies, local governments and authorities to invest \$500 million in clean technology development companies through the Common Retirement Fund.
