Forest Forensics

Session 1: July 12-15 / Session 4: Aug 2-5

Can you escape the Sanctuary? From scat, to tracks, to camouflage, the forest is full of mysteries! Join us as we work together to uncover the hidden world in our own back yard. Practice basic tracking techniques, learn to read clues in the landscape, and discover the adaptations that help animals survive in the wilderness.

Water Warriors

Session 2: July 19-22 / Session 7: Aug 23-26

Make a splash this summer! Catch frogs and tadpoles in the pond, go seine-netting for fish and crabs in the cove, and get your splash on playing games and running through a water obstacle course.

We Can Wing It!

Session 3: July 26-29 / (Ages 10-15 Kayak Session A only)

Let your imagination take flight as we explore nature's many animals (and even some plants) that soar through the sky! Investigate how wings work, create flying crafts, and discover how far your creativity can go.

Wilderness Warriors

Session 5: Aug 9-12 / Session 8: Aug 30-Sept 2

Not all who wander are lost! Spend the week honing your outdoors adventure skills. Work with your fellow campers to build awesome shelters, make survival tools, and get crafty with natural materials. Walk away with your own survival kit!

Mud Madness Mania

Session 6: Aug 16-19 / (Ages 10-15 Kayak Session B only)

Come get messy and muck around in the pond. Discover what plants and animals in the pond by exploring the water and mud with dip nets, buckets, and magnifiers. Dress for the mess!

SPECIAL PROGRAM: Kayak Exploration

Session A: July 26-29 / Session B: Aug 16-19 / ages 10-15 only

Embark on new adventures every day! After learning the proper techniques, paddle into Oyster Bay and beyond to learn about unique aquatic habitats. Kayaks, paddles, and life vests are provided. Protective, water-safe footwear is a must. *In case of inclement weather, we will spend the day at the Sanctuary.*

CANCELLATION POLICY

- **75% refund** if cancelled two or more weeks prior to your session start date.
 - **20% refund** if cancelled one week prior to your session start date.
- A written request for cancellation is required.**

If TRSAC cancels a session, we will provide a full refund less a \$25 processing fee per participant per session, or the opportunity to donate or apply the amount towards a future program.

If a participant is cancelling due to potential or confirmed COVID-19 exposure, TRSAC will issue the full refund, less \$25 processing fee per participant per session.
